PARENT VOLUNTEERS

If you are interested in chaperoning or volunteering in the classroom or with the Home & School, etc., in accordance with HRCE's Student Protection Policy, all volunteers will provide:

- 1. A completed Child Abuse Register Request for Search Form, which can be found https://beta.novascotia.ca/apply-child-abuse-register-search
- 2. A certified and true copy of a Criminal Records Check with <u>Vulnerable Sector Check</u> available from your local Police or RCMP detachment or through online organizations endorsed by Nova Scotia law enforcement agencies https://www.halifax.ca/fire-police/police/criminal-record-check

REMEMBRANCE DAY OBSERVANCES

Students in grades PP to 6 will be attending a Remembrance Day Assembly in honor of our veterans and those presently serving in the Armed Forces. The assembly will be held outside at 10:30 (weather permitting) on Thursday, November 7th. If necessary due to weather conditions, we will move the ceremony to the gymnasium. Students who belong to a service organization such as: any level of Scouts Canada or Girl Guides of Canada, Cadets, etc., are welcome to wear their uniform.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Did you know? HRCE takes great care when making the decision to alter the regular operations of schools and school buses in the event of severe or inclement weather.

It is HRCE's goal to communicate any changes to the regular operations of schools and/or buses as close to 6:00 a.m. as possible. **A 6:00 a.m. announcement could be:**

- All schools are delayed in opening by two hours and bus pickups are delayed by two hours; or
- All schools are open, but some or all busses are not operating for the day; or
- Some schools (either individually or by family) are closed for the day; or
- · All schools are closed for the day.

If weather deteriorates, or is forecasted to worsen throughout the morning, an 11:00 a.m. announcement could be:

- Bussed students will be picked up two hours earlier than their regular dismissal time; and
- Walking students will be dismissed at their regularly scheduled lunch hour.
